How to PGE-Exam

Duration



- The editing time is 120 minutes.
- Prior there are 10 minutes to read the tasks.
- Total duration: 130 minutes



Permitted Aids



- Non-programmable calculators
- Dictionaries (Only real books)! Electronic Dictionaries are not permitted! Dictionaries will get checked by us at the start of the exam.
- Red pens and pencils are not permitted! Use a normal (black or blue) ball-point pen.
- Own paper, Notebooks or similar is not needed.
 The required paper for the exam will be provided in sufficient quantity.



Processing the exam



- The Exam consists of a collection of exercises and a double sided answer sheet.
- Solutions have to be marked solely on the answer sheet. Notes on the collection of exercises are permitted but will not be graded.
- Answers on the collection of exercises will not be graded. The back of the sheet can be used for calculations.
- Corrections can be done by blackening the set cross and putting a new cross.



Processing the exam



- A manual correction is only needed, if an already blacked out box is chosen again.
- Then the cross to be graded has to be marked **clearly** on both the answer sheet and the collection of exercises. (e.g. by circling it or setting an arrow).
- The number of the task to be manually corrected has to be noted in the designated area on the collection of excercises.

Manual correction: Only enter tasks for which you would like to have a blackened cross scored (clearly mark the correct solution on both the collection of exercises as well as the answer sheet).

Scoring Rating



- No less than 0 points can be achieved per sub-task.
- Single Choice: Points will be awarded only for the correct solution.
- Multiple Choice: Points will be given for every correctly set cross and correctly not set cross. Wrongly set crosses or wrongly not set crosses lead to point deduction.
- The stated points are showing the maximum achievable points of the task.



Scoring Rating



The sub tasks are independent of one another.

Scoring

Evaluation factor



■ The evaluation factor states the weighting of a correctly and correctly not set cross (one checkbox always has a basis of 1 point. This will be multiplied by the evaluation factor).



Scoring Single Choice



- Only one cross is permitted in a single choice task.
- There is only one possible answer.
- Wrong answers and multiple crosses lead to 0 points.
- Single choice tasks are indicated by: Note: Only one answer is possible. Wrong answers lead to 0 points.

Scoring Multiple Choice



- More than one cross is permitted in a multiple choice task.
- There are one or more possible answers.
- Wrong answers (wrongly set crosses and wrongly not set crosses) lead to point deduction.
- Multiple choice tasks are indicated by: Note: Multiple answers are possible. Wrong answers will be penalized.
